## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Street, John Day, Oregon 97845, phone 575-1731, for the use of the waters of SW-7 Spring, a tributary of Bear Creek,

for the PURPOSE of livestock watering

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 3, 1981

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.25 gpm.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 700 feet North and 2,000 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 14, being within SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
