PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS 15702

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **63099** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Palmer Creek Water District Improvement Company of PO Box 152, Dayton, Oregon 97114, phone 864-2442,** for the use of the waters of Willamette River.

for the PURPOSE of **irrigation and supplemental supply for nursery operations which includes use for containerized stock and in greenhouses; being ~~2.28~~ cubic foot per second for irrigation, 7.0 cfs for containerized nursery stock and 7.5 cfs for use in greenhouses**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **December 7, 1981 for ~~1.99~~ cfs for irrigation and ~~14.5~~ cfs for nursery uses, January 4, 1983 for ~~0.08~~ cfs for irrigation and January 5, 1983 for use of ~~0.21~~ cfs, for irrigation**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **16.87** cfs.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **4,700 feet North and 1,290 feet East from the Southeast Corner of Gay DLC 38, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 4, Township 6 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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Actual construction work shall begin on or before **April 29, 1984** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
