## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64424 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Arnold A. and Catherine Pitts of 2819 Jumpoff Joe Creek, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 479-6857, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream with any deficiency in the available supply to be made up by a diversion from three springs.  
for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 11, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.2 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Unnamed Stream - 1,200 feet North and 230 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 31; Spring 2 - 700 feet North and 220 feet West from Southeast Corner of Section 31; Spring 3 - 1,125 feet North and 500 feet West from Southeast Corner of Section 31; Spring 4 - 1,125 feet North and 600 feet West from Southeast Corner of Section 31; all being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 31, Township 34 South, Range 5 West, WM, in \*

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 29, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
