PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64571 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Teresa C. Millar, for the United States, Deschutes National Forest, 1960 Southwest Camelot Court, Apartment 203, Portland, Oregon 97225, phone 297-3885, for the use of the waters of the Metolius River.

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 7, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,400 feet North and 1,300 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 15, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Jefferson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 13 South, Range 9 East, WM Section 15 NW 1/4 SE 1/4

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
