## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64587 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Horace Arthur Daum of 2320 Riverdale Road, Hood River, Oregon 97031, phone 386-4474, for the use of the waters of 3 unnamed streams, tributaries of Hood River, being 0.75 cubic foot per second from Unnamed Stream 1 with any deficiency in the available supply\* for the PURPOSE of frost protection, irrigation and fish culture, being 0.75 cfs for frost protection and 0.20 cfs for irrigation from Unnamed Stream 1 with any deficiency in the supply of water from Unnamed Stream 1 to be made up by diversion from Unnamed Stream 2 and 3 provided \*\* that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 21, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.85 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 700 feet South and 990 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 16, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 16; Diversion 2 - 1,360 feet South and 1,500 feet West; Diversion 3 - 1,402 feet South and 1,880 feet West both from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 16, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 16, Township 2 North, Range 10 East, WM, in the County of Hood River.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- \* of water to be made up by diversion from Unnamed Stream 2 and Unnamed Stream 3, and 0.10 cfs from Unnamed Stream 2 with any deficiency to be supplied by Unnamed Stream 3.
- \*\* the total diverted does not exceed 0.75 cfs and 0.10 cfs for fish culture from Unnamed Stream 2 with any deficiency to be supplied by Unnamed Stream 3

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for frost protection on forms furnished.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985. Extended to October 1987 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989. Extended to October 1, 1991 \*

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986. Extended to October 1, 1988. Extended to October 1, 1991 \*
