PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64588 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mary Campbell Myers of 1650 Southwest McLain Street, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 673-8766, for the use of the waters of South Umpqua River, tributary of Umpqua River.

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 22, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.21 Cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED. Diversion 1 - 100 feet North and 380 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 2, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 36, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, WM; Diversion 2 - 1,050 feet South and 1,920 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 2, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 28 South, Range 6 West, WM; in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 27 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 35 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 6.2 acres Section 36 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.4 acre Township 28 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 2 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 3.5 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 6.9 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before $\frac{May 11, 1984}{85}$, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86
