PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64592 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Betty M. Hayes of Route 1, Box 9, Logsden, Oregon 97357, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, tributary of Siletz River and reservoir, to be constructed under Application R-64591, Permit R-8609.

for the PURPOSE of irrigation, domestic use for one family and stock water; being 0.22 cubic foot per second for irrigation, 0.005 cfs for domestic use and 0.005 cfs for stock water

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 22, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.23 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: South 79 degrees 35 minutes East, 3,158 feet from the Northwest Corner of Section 29, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 29, Township 9 South, Range 9 West, WM; in the County of Lincoln.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8609, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
