PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

64605 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jerry and/or Shirley M. Stone of 5500 Lost Creek Road, Eagle Point, Oregon 97524, phone 826-7213, for the use of the waters of Stone Reservoirs 1,2,3 and 4, to be constructed under Application R-64604, Permit R-8610, tributaries of South Fork Little Butter for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 29, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 25.4 acre-feet stored water only, being 9.0 af from Reservoir 1, 6.0 af from Reservoir 2, 9.0 af from Reservoir 3 and 1.4 af from Reservoir 4.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED:

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Frog Creek - 375 feet South and 595 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 10, being within NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 10; Unnamed Stream - 100 feet North and 1,025 feet East from W 1/4 Corner of Section 15, being within SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 15; Dam 1 - 300 feet North and 1,080 feet East from Southwest Corner of Section 3, being within SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 3; Dam 2 - 400 feet South and 1,260 feet East from Northwest Corner of Section 10, being within NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 10; Dam 3 - 400 feet South 1,510 feet East from Northwest Corner of Section 10, being within NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 10; Dam 4 - 770 feet South and 50 feet East from Northwest Corner of Section 10, being within NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 10; all within Township 37 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

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
