## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63599 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to James G. and Shirlee D. Perkins of 11404 Southwest Breyman Court, Portland, Oregon 97219, phone 636-4431, for the use of the waters of a spring and an unnamed drainageway and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-64907, Permit R-8668, being\* for the PURPOSE of stock water

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 4, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 Cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Pond - 1430 feet North and 900 feet West; Spring - 1430 feet North and 700 feet West, both from the Southeast Corner of Section 11, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 8 South, Range 17 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* 0.005 cubic foot per second from spring and 0.005 cfs from unnamed drainageway, tributary of Trout Creek

Township 8 South, Range 17 East, WM Section 11 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 stock water

Actual construction work shall begin on or before  $\frac{\text{May 31, 1984}}{\text{reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19}}{\text{May 31, 1984}}$ , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86
