PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63807 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jack A. Lloyd of Route 1, Box 98C Gaston, Oregon 97119, phone 640-1311, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden, provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year, water shall be* that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 30, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed second 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: East 9.00 chains and South 12.00 chains from the Center of Section 19, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 19, Township I South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* diverted only for human consumption during period July 31 through September 15 of each year

Township 1 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 19 NE 1/4 SW 1/4

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 31, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
