PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64971 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to LaMont Davidson of 241 Rice Creek Road, Winston, Oregon 97496, phone 679-8892, for the use of the waters of Rice Creek when available, with any deficiency in the available supply from Rice Creek to be made up by appropriation from South Umpqua River,* for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 1, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.09 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 720 feet South and 440 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 4, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 4, Township 29 South, Range 6 West, WM; Diversion 2 - 75 feet North and 120 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 4, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 33, Township 28 South, Range 6 West, WM, both in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

Township 29 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 5.1 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 2.1 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
