PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64737 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William David Lane of PO Box 51, Westlake, Oregon 97493, phone 997-3072, for the use of the waters of Tsiltcoos Lake.

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 17, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second of water

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2400 feet South and 3600 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 34, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 19 South, Range 12 West, WM Section 34 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 domestic use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 13, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
