This permit is issued to Noyes Whitten of Box 366, Mill City, Oregon 97360, phone 897-2298, for the use of the waters of the North Santiam River, tributary of the Willamette River.

for the PURPOSE of commercial use for truck washing

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 15, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 30 gallons per minute of water

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 700 feet North and 400 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 29, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 9 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Linn.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South, Range 3 East, WM Section 29 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 commercial use for truck washing

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 13, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19  $^{85}$  .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
