PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64943 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John Griffin of 14875 Southeast 262nd, Broing, Oregon 97009, phone 663-5484, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-64942, Permit R-8671. for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 21, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second of water

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1300 feet South and 110 West from the NE Corner of Section 11, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 2 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 South, Range 3 East, WM

Section II NE 1/4 NE 1/4

18.7 acres

NW 1/4 NE 1/4

0.7 acre

Section 12 NW 1/4 NW 1/4

0.6 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit 8671, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 13, 1984 , and shareasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
