PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **63802** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **John F. Wood of Route 1, Box 328, Forest Grove, Oregon 97116, phone 357-6232, for the use of the waters of a drainage ditch, tributary of West Dairy Creek.**

for the PURPOSE of **Irrigation and supplemental irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **July 29, 1982 for use of 5.6 gallons per minute, February 25, 1983 for use of 194.4 gpm**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **200 gpm.**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **50 feet North and 375 feet West from the Center Corner of Section 9, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Washington.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM	Section 9	SE 1/4	NW 1/4	<u>Primary</u> 2.5 acres
		SE 1/4	NW 1/4	<u>Supplemental</u> 21.5 acres
		NE 1/4	SW 1/4	12.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year except for human and livestock consumption, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **June 13, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
