PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **64161** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **C. Stephan Bratt and L. Jane Bratt of 7620 Smullen Road, Mt. Hood, Oregon 97041, phone 352-6298, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream**

for the PURPOSE of **domestic use for one family during the nonirrigation season, and irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 15, 1982, for 0.01 cubic foot per second, May 11, 1983 for 0.005 cfs**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.015 cfs.**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **600 feet North and 480 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 4, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 1 South, Range 10 East, WM, in the County of Hood River.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 South, Range 10 East, WM Section 4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 domestic use and 0.5 acre during the nonirrigation season

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **June 13, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
