PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **64613** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Special Trees Nursery of Route 1, Box 214A, Dayton Oregon 97114, phone 868-7971, for the use of the waters of Palmer Creek and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-64612, Permit R-8650** for the PURPOSE of **nursery operations which includes use on containerized stock in greenhouses**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **January 4, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **15.0 cubic feet per second.**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Palmer Creek - 700 feet North and 1500 feet East from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 7, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 8; Reservoir - 140 feet North and 3080 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 7, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 7, Township 5 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
