PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John M. and Dorothy B. Phillips of 89084 Blue View Drive, Veneta, Oregon 97487, phone 935-1020, for the use of the waters of Fern Ridge Reservoir, constructed under Permit R-1625

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 10, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed water anily.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED. 545 feet South and 1380 feet West from the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 20, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 20, Reservoir - SE 1/4 of Section 4; Township 17 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 17 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 20 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 one-third acre irrigation, intermittent summer use only

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from reservoir constructed under Permit R-1625, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 3-07-10-W0472 between the Burequ of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
