for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 10, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 6.005 cubic foot per

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 150 feet North and 1000 feet West from the Southwest Corner of the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 9, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 37 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.
