PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61955 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jake Kultert of 615 Messinger Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 846-6317, for the use of the waters of Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810, tributary of Applegate River for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 6, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 40-0 acre-feet stored water only

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1050 feet South and 500 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 25, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 25, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM, Applegate Lake Dam is located within the SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 17 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 8-8 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 11-0 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4 15-0 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 4-2 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0372 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
