for the PURPOSE of

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 18, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

0.03 cubic foot per

780 feet South and 350 feet West from the Northeast Corner The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be 100ATED 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 24, Township 3 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
