## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Wallace and Lorin Stanciu of Richland, Oregon 97870, phone 893-3137 or 893-3141, for the use of the waters of Spring 1 and Spring 2, tributary of Strang Gulch**

for the PURPOSE of **irrigation and supplemental irrigation, domestic use for one family and stock water, being 0.55 cubic foot per second of water for irrigation and supplemental irrigation (0.30 cfs from Spring 1 and 0.25 cfs from Spring 2), 0.01 cfs for domestic use for one family (0.005 cfs\* that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 10, 1983 for 0.56 cfs and May 5, 1983 for 0.01 cfs**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.57 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Spring 1 - 75 feet North and 3700 feet West, Spring 2 - 130 feet North and 2900 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 24, both being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 24, Township 9 South, Range 44 East, WM, in the County of Baker.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:  
\* **from each spring), and 0.01 cfs for stock water (0.005 cfs from each spring)**

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 15, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 <sup>85</sup> . Extended to Oct. 1, 1986

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 <sup>86</sup> .
