PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **64515** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife of 506 Southwest Mill Street, Portland, Oregon 97208, phone 229-5701, for the use of the waters of Ana River via Summer Lake Irrigation District Canal, tributary Summer Lake** for the PURPOSE of **restoring and maintaining potholes and marshland for wildlife habitat during the period May 15 through September 15 of each year**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **November 1, 1982**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **8.0 cubic feet per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **1200 feet North and 2250 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 6, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 30 South, Range 17 East, WM, in the County of Lake.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 15, 1984** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19**85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19**86**.
