PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65038 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to PO Box 85, Beatty, Oregon 97621, phone 533-2471, for the use of the waters of Sprague River, tributary of Williamson River

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 22, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed second 1.96 cubic foot per

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - North 49 degrees 42 minutes West 5375 feet; Diversion 2 - North 48 degrees 22 minutes West 5150 feet; Diversion 3 - North 43 degrees 22 minutes West 4615 feet from the Southeast Corner of Section 16, being within Government Lot 11 and 14, all in SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, Township 36 South, Range 12 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 36 South, Range 12 East, WM Section 16 G.L. I + G.L. 8 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4)
G.L. 9 and G.L. 16 36.1 acres
North of railroad
(SE 1/4 NE 1/4)
That portion of 2.4 acres
G.L. 17 North of
railroad

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
