PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65043 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ricard H. Dowers and Donna Lee Dowers of 16631 Southeast 232nd Drive, Boring, Oregon 97009, phone 658-3110, for the use of an unnamed stream, tributary of Noyer Creek,

for the PURPOSE of livestock watering

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 25, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 360 feet South and 330 feet West from the N I/4 Corner of Section 15, being within the NE I/4 NW I/4 of Section 15, Township 2 South, Renge 3 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 South, Range 3 East, WM Section 15 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Stock water

Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
