## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **64796** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Charlie Trefethen of 32577 Redwood Highway, O'Brien, Oregon 97534, for the use of the waters of a spring area, tributary Democrat Gulch,**

for the PURPOSE of **mining**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **June 7, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.4 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **1350 feet North and 2160 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 3, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 3, Township 40 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This permit is issued subject to the maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning the water to the stream.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 27, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
