## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION

and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Sherwood, Oregon B. Kenny (Oregon Azalea's, Incorporated) of Route 4, Box 405K, Sherwood, Oregon 97140, phone 620-8011 for the use of the waters of Tuelatin River and 45.0 acre-feet stored water from Henry Hagg Lake, tributary Williamette River, constructed under \* for the PURPOSE of greenhouse and containerized nursery operation, being 100 gallons per minute for each use not to exceed 100 gpm maximum

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 28, 1983 for 100 gpm and 30.0 af; June 16, 1983 for 15.0 af

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

100 gallons per minute

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 5050 feet North and 1460 feet West from the SW Corner of NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 18, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 18, Township 2 South, Range I West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Henry Hagg Lake is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20, Township I South, Range 4 West, WM.

Township 2 South, Range I West, WM Section 18 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 2-1 acres

containerized nursery greenhouse operation

No water shall be diverted except from storage during the period July 31 through September 15 of each year. The use of stored water shall be subject to the terms and conditions of a contract between the permittee and the Tualatin Valley Irrigation District, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with Extended to October 1, 1988

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
