PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64839 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Gene and Barbra Byers of 3693 15-Mile Road, Willis J. and Rosemary Shank of 3705 15-Mile Road, and Harry L. and Myrtle P. Wickman of 3723 15-Mile Road, all of The Dalles, Oregon 97338, phone 298-8152, for the use of the waters of West Spring when available \* for the PURPOSE of domestic use for three families

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 11, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: West Spring - 2450 feet South and 2025 feet East; East Spring - 2480 feet South and 2100 feet East both from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 32, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 32, Township 2 North, Range 14 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- \* with any deficiency in the available supply from the West Spring to be made up by diversion from the East Spring, provided that the total quantity diverted from both springs shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second of water, tributary 15-Mile Creek,

Township 2 North, Range 14 East, WM Section 32 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use NW 1/4 SW 1/4

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 27, 1984 85 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986 .
