## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **64841** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Richard D. and Diane Koenig of 11786 Kingdom Lane, SE, Stayton, Oregon 97383, phone 769-6778** for the use of the waters of **Detroit Reservoir** constructed under **Permit R-1625, tributary Willamette River,** for the PURPOSE of **irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **February 11, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **111.9 acre-feet stored water only**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 1 - 840 feet South and 1840 feet East; Diversion 2 - 760 feet South and 2950 feet East** both from the NW Corner of Section 22, being within the 1 - NE 1/4 NW 1/4; 2 - NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 22, Township 9 South, Range 1 East, WM, in the County of Marion. **Detroit Dam** is located within the NW 1/4 of Section 7, T10S, R5E, WM.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2.5 acre-feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of **Contract 3-07-10-W0476** between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 27, 1984** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1985**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1986**.
