## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **64961** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Kenneth L. and Karen L. Tuttle of Route 5, Box 1310, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 884-4224** for the use of the waters of **Williamson River, tributary Upper Klamath Lake,**

for the PURPOSE of **Irrigation and supplemental irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **March 29, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **6.31 cubic feet per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **North 11 degrees 05 minutes East 2030 feet from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 15, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 34 South, Range 7 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.**

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to  $\frac{1}{40}$  of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

July 27, 1984

Actual construction work shall begin on or before 85, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 .

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Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 .
