PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **64993** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Oceanside Water District of PO Box 239, Oceanside, Oregon 97134, phone 842-6462** for the use of the waters of Short Creek, tributary Pacific Ocean,

for the PURPOSE of **quasi-municipal**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **April 7, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **1.0 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **3070.29 feet North and 72.47 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 19, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 19, Township 1 South, Range 10 West, WM, in the County of Tillamook.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
