PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

65133 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Robert J. Kelly and Betty M. Kelly of 3545 Salem-Dallas Highway, NW, Salem, Oregon 97304, phone 362-3915 for the use of storage of water of a spring, an unnamed stream, and a reservoir, tributary Willamette River to be constructed under * irrigation for the PURPOSE of

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

May 19, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

0.12 cfs

Unnamed Stream - 680 feet North and 960 feet East; Spring -The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED, both from the Center Corner of Section 30, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Application R-65132, Permit R-8659; being 0.03 cubic foot per second of water from the spring and 0.09 cfs from unnamed stream and reservoir,

Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 30 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 7.3 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.1 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
