PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65133** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Robert J. Kelly and Betty M. Kelly of 3545 Salem-Dallas Highway, NW, Salem, Oregon 97304, phone 362-3915** for the use of storage of water of a spring, an unnamed stream, and a reservoir, tributary Willamette River to be constructed under *
for the PURPOSE of **irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **May 19, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.12 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Unnamed Stream - 680 feet North and 960 feet East; Spring - 750 feet North and 710 feet East, both from the Center Corner of Section 30, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 30, Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Polk.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * **Application R-65132, Permit R-8659; being 0.03 cubic foot per second of water from the spring and 0.09 cfs from unnamed stream and reservoir,**

**Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 30 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 7.3 acres
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.1 acres**

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 27, 1984** **85**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
