PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65085** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **George Horning of Route 3, Box 588, Corvallis, Oregon 97330, phone 753-3004, for the use of the waters of Willamette River,**

for the PURPOSE of **irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **May 12, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **2.19 cubic feet per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 3 - 550 feet South and 2820 feet East from the NW Corner SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 25, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 25; Diversion 6 - 3630 feet North and 1890 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 36, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 36, both within Township 13 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Benton.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 29, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19**85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19**86**.
