## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION

65138

and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to C.N. Versteeg of 441 Junction Avenue, Cave Junction, Oregon 97523, phone 592-3771, for the use of the waters of Illinois River, a tributary of Rogue River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 23, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed second, being 0.195 cubic foot per second of water for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for domestic use

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED. 1700 feet North and 1125 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 17, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 39 South, Range 8 West, WM Section 17 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 9.1 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.9 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/50 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19  $^{86}$  .
