## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65159** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Florence Cleland c/o Glenn Cleland of Box 14, Adel, Oregon 97620, phone 947-2945, for the use of the waters of Deep Creek, a tributary of Warner Lakes,**

for the PURPOSE of **irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **May 31, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **6.1 cubic feet per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Diversion 1 - 2000 feet South and 2820 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 20, being within NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20; Diversion 2 - 550 feet North and 1650 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 22, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 22, both within Township 39 South, Range 24 East, WM, in the County of Lake.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 29, 1984** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**. Extended to Oct. 1, 1986

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
