## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **63249** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Deschutes Valley Water District of Route 1, Box 17, Madras, Oregon 97741, phone 475-3849, for the use of the waters of Crooked River, a tributary of Deschutes River.**

for the PURPOSE of **the development of 7977 theoretical horsepower at the Opal Springs Hydroelectric installation.**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **February 10, 1982 for 1500 cfs, June 10, 1982 for 272.5 cfs**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **2,102.02 feet South, 89 degrees 54 minutes 30 seconds West and 389.30 feet South, 3 degrees 15 minutes East from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 33, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 33, Township 12 South, Range 12 East WM, in the County of Jefferson.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Township 12 South, Range 12 East, WM Section 33 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 hydroelectric power generation**

The right granted herein is expressly made inferior in right and subsequent in time to any appropriation of water from this source which may hereafter be made for domestic, municipal, irrigation or any other beneficial consumptive use, or for storage for such purposes, provided further that the project shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered professional engineer, provided further that the permittee shall comply with the provisions of the order of the Water Policy Review Board dated September 17, 1982 and by reference herein made part of this permit.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **August 3, 1984** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
