PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64944 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Dorothy Cathey of PO Box 125, Murphy, Oregon 97533, phone 826-2287, for the use of the waters of Applegate River and 1.0 acre-foot stored water only from Applegate Lake, reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 22, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2220 feet South and 1980 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 21, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Josephine. Applegate Dam is located SE 1/4, Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 21 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 1.0 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0345 between the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 25, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
