64947 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64947 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Patrick N. Larkin of 156 North Schoneman, Coos Bay, Oregon 97420, phone 888-6506, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Ross Inlet,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 23, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 380 feet South and 545 feet East from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 24, being within the NW I/4 NE I/4 of Section 24, Township 26 South, Range 13 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South, Range 13 West, WM Section 24 NW I/4 NE I/4 Domestic use including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 25, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
