PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **63118** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Murray Spring Water Association of Box 127, Rufus, Oregon 97050, phone 739-2871 or 739-2511, for the use of the waters of Murray Spring, a tributary of Columbia River,**

for the PURPOSE of **irrigation, commercial use in a 24 space trailer park including laundry and bath house, and domestic use for nine families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre in area lawn and garden for seven families, being 1.75 cubic feet per second of water for *** that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **December 15, 1981**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not **exceed 1.91 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **340 feet North and 1190 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 1, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 2 North, Range 16 East WM, in the County of Sherman.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* **irrigation, 0.1 cfs for commercial use and 0.03 cfs for domestic use.**

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 25, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
