and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John M. Ward and MaryLou Ward of Box 186A, North Myrtle Route, Myrtle Creek, Oregon 97457, for the use of the waters of North Myrtle Creek, a tributary of Myrtle Creek,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family.

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 25, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed second 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 260 feet South and 650 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 24, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 24, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 13 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 25, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
