## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

64899 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Wayne C. Chetwood of RFD Box 51, Halfway, Oregon 97834, phone 742-2642, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Pine Creek,

for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 28, 1983

0.28 cubic foot per and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **second** 

1900 feet North and 1995 feet West from the Southeast The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1700 leet North and 1797 leet west from the 30theast Corner of Section 36, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 36, Township 7 South, Range 45 East, WM, in the County of Baker.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 7 South, Range 45 East, WM, Section 36 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 9.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4 2.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
