## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64845 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Walter A. Sprague of 85516 Springfield-Creswell Highway, Pleasant Hill, Oregon 97455, phone 747-9607, for the use of the waters of Middle Fork Willamette River

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 17, 1983 for 0.013 cubic foot per second and March 14, 1983 for 1.987 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 3450 feet North and 600 feet East from the Southeast Corner of Section 22, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 18 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 20, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
