PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64849 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mildred L. Frick of 24810 Redwood Highway, Kerby, Oregon 97531, phone 592-3003, for the use of the waters of Illinois River, tributary of Rogue River

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 18, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 200 feet North and 300 feet East from the Southwest Corner of NE 1/4 SW 1/4, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 9 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 12.0 acres primary NE 1/4 SW 1/4 3.0 acres supplem Township 39 South, Range 8 West, WM 3.0 acres supplemental

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/50 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 20, 1984 Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 20, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 Extended to October 1, 1988
