PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65044** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **John W. Sweet** of **1160 North 10th Street, Coos Bay, Oregon 97420**, phone **269-9049**, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and two reservoirs to be constructed under Application R-65236, Permit R-8803, tributary of Sixes River for the PURPOSE of **irrigation, frost control and flood harvesting of cranberries**, being **0.46 cubic foot per second** for each use provided the total diverted shall not exceed **0.46 cfs**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **April 26, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.46 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Reservoir 1 - 1050 feet South from the Northwest Corner of Section 31, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 31; Reservoir 2 - 1450 feet South and 1980 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 31, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 31, Township 31 South, Range 15 West, WM; in the County of Curry.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 31 South, Range 15 West, WM Section 31 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 20.0 acres irrigation, frost control, flood harvesting

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **September 20, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
