## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65224 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Warm Springs Irrigation District of 334 Main Street, North, Vale, Oregon 97918, phone 473-3951, for the use of the waters of Malheur River and Warm Springs Reservoir constructed under Permit R-457, tributary of Snake River for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 24, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 390 feet South and 230 feet East from the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 8; being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 8, Township 19 South, Range 44 East, WM, in the County of Malheur.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 18 South, Range 45 West, WM Section 31 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 5.2 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from Warm Springs Reservoir constructed under Permit R-457, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
