### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65233 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ernest S. and/or Louella P. Bieri of 10074 Caves Highway, Cave Junction, Oregon 97523, phone 592-2824, for the use of the waters of Lake Creek, tributary of Sucker Creek

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 27, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1200 feet North and 1150 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 24; being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 24, Township 39 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 39 South, Range 7 West, WM Section 24 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
