PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65574 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to E. John Yoder of 37150 SE Yoder Road, Estacada, Oregon 97023, phone 630-6662, for the use of the waters of Salt Creek, tributary of Yamhill River

for the PURPOSE of Irrigation and stock water, being 0.120 cfs 0.012 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for stock water

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 17, 1983 for 0.12 cfs and August 19, 1983 for 0.005 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 400 feet South and 1700 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 14, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 6 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 14 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 8.1 acres irrigation and stock use
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 1.4 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
