PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62934 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Leonard Knight of Box 548, Wallowa, Oregon 97885, phone 886-7081, for the use of the waters of unnamed Stream 1 with any deficiency in the available supply of water from unnamed Stream 1 to be made up by appropriation from Stream 2, tributaries of the Powder * for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 2, 1981

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.79 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 1400 feet North and 600 feet East; Diversion 2 - 2630 feet North and 1600 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 18, being within the Diversion 1 - NW 1/4 SW 1/4; Diversion 2 - NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, WM; in the County of Baker.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South, Range 45 East, WM Section 18 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 4.5 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4 25.1 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4 2.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before $\frac{\text{October 11, 1984}}{\text{reasonable diligence}}$, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
