PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65298 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Franklin F. and Anna M. Jones of Box 1389, Winston, Oregon 97496, phone 679-5440, for the use of the waters of Olalla Creek, tributary Lookingglass Creek,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1740 feet North and 370 feet West from the S1/4 Corner of Section 8, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 29 South, Range 7 West, WM; in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South, Range 7 West, WM Section 8 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 11, 1984 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 .
